As a close to this update of my work, I have spoken with several reliable sources and their collective consensus on the Great Northern Multi Modal Transportation Plan, is the plan is geared to receiving grant(s) for traffic light synchronization on Lorain Road and for replacement of the concrete curbing on Country Club Blvd. from Great Northern Blvd. westward. I do not believe we will see a bike path or repaving of Butternut Ridge Road, at least, not at this time. This is my reason for pursuing the bike path down Cedar Point Road as a place of beginning. Hopefully more will follow. The curbs on Country Club Blvd. do need to be replaced, as early as 2006 and also very recently, I suggested to the Westfield Mall Manager that the property owners on Country Club Blvd. and the City should share the cost of the replacement of the concrete curbing. The involvement of the property owners and businesses on Country Club Blvd. with the street improvements is self-serving and in the best interests of the business community.
