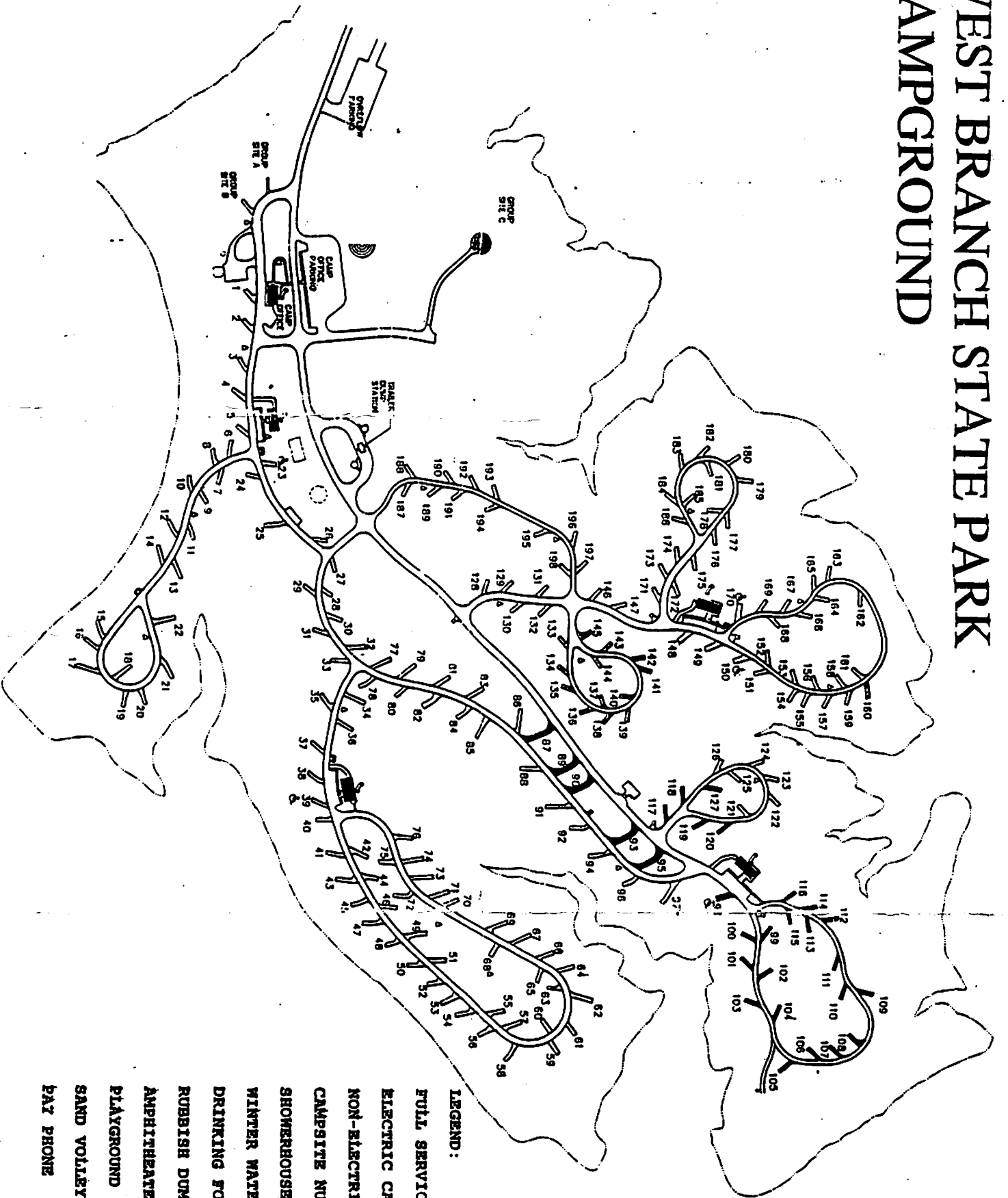














WEST BRANCH STATE PARK CAMPGROUND

New Weekday Rates Sunday - Thursday

\$18 per night - non-electric site April-Oct (summer)

\$22 per night - electric site April - Oct (summer)

\$28 per night - full hook-up April - Oct (summer)

New Weekend & Holiday Rates

\$1 additional fee for all Fri. and Sat. nights from May 20 to September 11, 2005.

\$1 additional fee for Fri., Sat. & Sun. nights during the Memorial Day, Fourth of July & Labor Day weekends.

\$16 per night - non-electric site Nov. - March (winter)

\$20 per night - electric site Nov. - March (winter)

Check out time is 1 pm; check in time is 3 pm.

Group Camp electric - \$35 per night per site

Group Camp non-electric - \$25 per night. Reservations are required and are made directly with the park office.

The three sites hold up to 25 - 30 people each.

Horse Camp - \$13 per night per site; reservations are required and made directly with the park office.

DISCOUNTS - GBC and Cardinal Camper Card

PETS are free and are allowed at all sites except 34 - 76. Pets are limited to two per site and must have owner's name and proof of rabies inoculation.

CAMPING RESERVATION INFORMATION

Campsites may now be reserved up to 6 months in advance by calling 1-866-OHIOPARKS (844-6727) or go on line at www.ohiostateparks.org. There is a non-refundable \$8 reservation fee for each site reserved. Our reservable sites are: 1-132 and 141-186. Campers without reservations may purchase reservable sites only if the site's availability has been checked by park staff first. Campers without reservations and unable to contact park staff may set up only on the 20 sites designated as walk ins (133-140 non-electric & 187-198 electric). The walk in sites will be held out of the reservation system for late arriving campers.

-Anyone registering before 6:00 am will be charged for the preceding night.

-Self-registration envelopes are available at the camp office when it is unattended. Follow instructions on the envelope and place the fee with all copies of the camping permit card in the envelope and then in the drop box located to right of the camp office main door.

-**Campers must register & pay fees before setting up.**

-Camping is limited to 14 days in a 30 day period.

-The daily camping card must be displayed on the numbered campsite post.

-Please turn the camping card in upon departure.

-Each campsite is limited to 6 persons.

PARKING Each site is limited to the vehicles that fit on the asphalt pad, parked end to end. Except for boat trailers, no vehicles, campers or RVs may be parked on the grass.

When parking a boat trailer on the grass, please keep the tow vehicle on the pavement.

EXTRA VEHICLE & VISITOR PASSES

Visitor vehicles are \$1 per day and must exit by 10:00 pm. Extra vehicle passes are \$1 each per day.

-Any vehicle that won't fit on your pad should be parked in the overflow lot, near the campground's entrance.

-Motor vehicle operation within the camp is restricted to licensed vehicles only and that which is necessary for direct transportation to and from a campsite. The speed limit is 10 MPH.

-Please be considerate of your neighbors by keeping noise to a minimum between the hours of 10 pm and 8 am. Generators may be run until 10 pm and not before 8 am.

-The showerhouse facilities are for current camping patrons only.

-Please rinse off muddy clothing before using the washers.

-Please don't wash dishes, hair or feet at the drinking fountains. Use wash sinks in front of showerhouses.

-Each showerhouse has a separate universally accessible shower room (ADA) that is designed to assist persons with disabilities. Requests to access this room by persons with disabilities can be made when registering.

-Leaving food and trash out at night will encourage raccoon damage. Do not feed raccoons; they can carry rabies and other diseases.

-Fires are permitted only in fire rings, grills or stoves. Cutting trees and gathering firewood is prohibited.

-Do not hang lanterns on trees; their heat damages the trees.

-Use of firearms, fireworks or chainsaws are prohibited.

-Pet owners must clean up after their pet.

-Bicycles are not permitted on hiking or bridle trails. Mountain bike trails are located at the West Boat Ramp.

-Alcoholic beverages are prohibited, **except in your camping unit.**

-Juveniles must have written permission from their parents to camp.

-A 3 foot minimum space is required between tents and other camping units.

The park also offers hiking trails, bike trails, hunting areas, summer nature programs, a swimming beach, picnic shelters, boat ramps, seasonal boat dock rental and a marina with boat rental, marine supplies and food.

For your convenience, we have Campground Hosts on sites designated by a "Campground Host" sign. Please see them if you need assistance.

The Park Officers are here for your safety, please report problems to them. They appreciate your cooperation.
